Today's Program: Senior APMP Speakers

Dick Eassom and David Winton, International APMP Board

- Dick and David presented a 10-minute slide show, which covered the history of APMP, its mission, growth in members and chapters over the years, corporate sponsors, APMP fellows, and more
- Today's APMP is an international org. with 4 international chapters; most recent is Germany
- APMP offers a variety of resources such as The Journal (magazine) and Perspective (newsletter)
- Web site: APMP.org (can see historical newsletters and journals), BD Knowledgebase (archives, fully searchable database, accreditation info), 2008 conference details – expecting 600+
- Soon on web site: forums or blogs, created by Board
- Reviewed the APMP Code of Ethics as well as benefits of accreditation and professional recognition
- 2008 Conference: The Tuesday before conf. starts, there will be a workshop to prepare folks to take the Foundation level exam; can sit for exam either immediately after or at a later date online.

John Elder, Editor of APMP Journal

- Journal Magazine is published twice annually; mailed hard copy to members. Peer review articles, such as conference research results, submit ideas for articles to John via Publications link on web site.
- **Perspective** Ali Paskun, editor. Request ideas for articles and be recognized for what you do. Newsletter is an online publication and is published quarterly.
- **Benefits of Publications** Offer examples of best practices; all issues are archived for future reference; book reviews; opportunity to publish

Betsy Blakney, APMP Regional Representative for Eastern U.S.

- Discussed benefits of membership including the opportunity to serve in a leadership or public speaking role
- Forum for sharing best practices and lessons learned via regional and international conferences
- Recognition as an "APMP Fellow" (41 currently)
- Networking opportunities
- Recommended that we immediately involve new members in our chapter and get them on a committee right away.



Keith Propst, GA APMP Chapter, Southern Proposal Accents Conference (SPAC) Representative

- Great resource for our profession
- 11th annual conf. held in 2007 in Raleigh Durham (previous 10 were in the Atlanta area)
- Approximately 130 attendees; participants from 20 states
- One-day conference loosely focused around a theme
- 2008 conference slated for Atlanta in mid-October (date and venue TBD)
- Hope to host SPAC in Florida or at least lend support within next few years
- Consider being a speaker at the Oct. conference; nice stepping stone to speaking at international conference
- Monitor APMP site to consider attending other chapters' regional or chapterbased conferences

Cal Vandivier, FL Chapter Membership Chair

- Great start to new chapter we have nearly 60 members thus far
- Need to keep momentum going via 2008 membership drive. Goal is to increase membership by 25% (i.e., 15 members)
- Looking at FL and neighboring states for member recruitment
- Submitted charter petition in Aug 2007 with 38 members; since then we've grown membership to 57 members
- Need to enlist non-affiliated members in FL and nearby states to join our chapter
- Will employ a 2-step approach:
 - Encourage unaffiliated FL and other APMP members to affiliate with us
 - Recruit new APMP members
- Growth opportunities in FL 23 possible folks within FL; establish metro-based recruiting teams
- Looking for volunteers to support recruitment efforts; a recruiting prize program which will continue throughout 2008
- Working hard to follow-up with new members; publicize our meetings in national publications
- Recruiting prize: Proposal Writing to Win Federal and National Laboratory Contracts, Joseph Jablonski. Winner who provided three leads was Terry Clayton, with WSI in West Palm Beach
